

DIRECTION


We, the Honourable Richard Ross Sinclair Tracey AM RFD QC and Ms Lynelle Jann Briggs AO, Commissioners of the Royal Commission established under Letters Patent dated 6 December 2018 to inquire into and report on Aged Care Quality and Safety, direct that:

1. In relation to Sydney Hearing, until further direction:
 - a. Counsel Assisting the Royal Commission shall provide written submissions to the Royal Commission by 5.00pm on Wednesday 29 May 2019;
 - b. any written submissions in reply to Counsel Assisting's submissions may be provided to the Royal Commission by parties with leave to appear at this hearing by no later than 5.00pm on Wednesday 5 June 2019;
 - c. any further written submissions in reply may be provided to the Royal Commission by no later than 5.00pm 3 business days after the submissions referred to in (b) are made available to parties with leave to appear;
 - d. documents referred to in submissions should be restricted to documents tendered in the Sydney Hearing, and exhibits before the Royal Commission referred to during the Sydney Hearing;
 - e. documents referred to in submissions must be identified by their Document ID and exhibit numbers;
 - f. submissions should use pseudonyms to refer to individuals whose names are the subject of a Pseudonym Direction pursuant to section 6D(3) of the *Royal Commissions Act 1902* (Cth);
 - g. submissions should be submitted to the Solicitors Assisting the Royal Commission; and
 - h. it is intended that submissions will be published in due course on the Royal Commission's website.
