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RESEARCH PROGRAM:

My research has focused on six major themes in the long term care area. The first is state variation in long term care policies, which led to my second important interest in state home and community-based services. At the same time, my principal research has focused on quality of care, nursing home staffing, regulation, and policy. This work led to my interest and work in developing a nursing home consumer information system for California, which expanded to include all long term care services and supports including home health and hospice care. In addition, I have studied managed care for the aged and international long term care.

State Variation in Long Term Care Policies and Programs

First, my research has focused on long term care services for the aged and disabled with a focus on five specific areas. First, I conducted a series of studies from 1980-2000 funded by the Health Care Financing Administration, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research on the variation in state long term care policies. This work was a collaborative effort with a team of sociologists, statisticians, and economists. We collected state long term care policies and made state data books available on the HCFA Website for other researchers and have published numerous empirical articles on state home care and nursing home policies, provider supply, certificate of need, utilization of services, reimbursement rates, and expenditures.

Home and Community Based Services

Second, since 1994, I have examined Medicaid home and community based service (HCBS) programs in all the states in the US, using funding from the Health Care Financing Administration until 1999. My work involved a review and critique of federal regulations and structured telephone surveys of all state Directors of Medicaid, waiver programs, personal care programs, screening programs, and statistical data collection for the period of 1992-1998. A number of data-based empirical papers were published from this major research effort describing the variation in state policies, barriers to the expansion of home and community based services, and predictors of state policy variation. From 2000 through the current time, the Kaiser Family Foundation has funded projects to continue collecting and analyzing data on state HCBS programs. We have published a number of papers and an annual report on HCBS from the Kaiser Commission on Medicaid and the Uninsured. Project leadership was assumed by Terence Ng in 2012, where he continues to collect and publish annual reports on HCBS for all states.

Related to this effort, I worked with the Center for Disability Statistics at UCSF, funded by the National Institute for Disability and Rehabilitation Research. In 2003, I became the principal investigator and director of a new five-year \$4.5 million national Center for Personal Assistance Services funded by the National Institute on Disability and Rehabilitation Research that was renewed for 2008-2013. This project involves collecting and analyzing data on Medicaid home and community based service (HCBS) programs and policies, workforce policies and practices, personal care services in the workplace, and statistical analyses of formal and informal services. In addition, the project is responsible for developing and presenting a national website (www.PAScenter.org) and for extensive training, dissemination, and technical assistance activities. For that project, I managed a team of UCSF faculty, graduate students, and staff, and subcontracts with six major organizations and universities. Presentations on the Center's research work have been given a numerous national and regional professional meetings.

This work was continued by S.H. Kaye with a grant for 2013-17 (where I serve as a co-PI) on Community Living Policy funded by the National Institute on Disability, Independent Living, and Rehabilitation Research. U.S. Department of Health & Human Services.

Managed Care and the Elderly

Third, another major research focus has been on managed care organizations and the elderly. I served as a co-principal investigator (with Robert Newcomer P.I.) on two major studies of Social Health Maintenance Organization Demonstration projects, funded by the Health Care Financing Administration between 1985-2000. The first project was an evaluation of four demonstration projects with approximately 8,000 enrollees, which resulted in a number of publications about the organization and delivery of services, utilization and expenditures, satisfaction and disenrollment patterns, and the outcomes of care. In the second project, we provided the conceptual model and

technical assistance for a health plan for the elderly that involved a coordinated effort between geriatricians and nurse case managers at different project sites.

In 2014, I joined a planning grant lead by Graham, C. that led to an Evaluation of the California Coordinated Care Initiative, funded by The SCAN Foundation in 2015-17. I served as a consultant on this grant to examine the new program for Medicaid dual eligibles to receive health and long term care services on supports through managed care organizations.

Quality of Care, Nursing Home Staffing, Regulation, and Policy

Fourth, one of my principal research focuses has been on the quality of nursing home care. I served on the Health Services Research panel for the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research (1995-99). In 1998-00, I completed a major report for the Health Care Financing Administration to revise the Medicare beneficiary consumer complaint review system for the US. I conducted a series of studies on nursing home quality of care and regulation as the Principal Investigator of an AHCPR grant to develop a nursing home consumer information system (1995-1999). This project analyzed the most important domains and indicators of quality and examined complex interrelationships between nursing facility characteristics, resident characteristics, staffing, and quality and resulted in a number of publications in leading journals.

In 2003, I published an article with J. Swan on the relationship between nursing home staffing, turnover, and casemix. In 2004, a paper with Jack Schnelle entitled Relationship of Nursing Home Staffing to Quality of Care was published in the prestigious Health Services Research journal, describing findings from our large study of over 800 residents in California nursing homes. This study demonstrated that higher nurse staffing levels in nursing homes are associated with improved processes of quality of care, but that there is a threshold for staffing levels before improved quality can be observed. I also conducted two small, related projects in 2001-02 to examine the financial status, bankruptcies, and closures in California nursing facilities.

My nursing home research has also focused on the regulatory enforcement of nursing home standards in the states. I received funding to study nursing facility regulation in states from the Kaiser Family Foundation. My studies on staffing and enforcement served as the basis for recent investigations of nursing homes by the U.S. General Accounting Office and the U.S. Inspector General, Department of Health and Human Services. I have presented testimony before the US Senate Special Committee on Aging (1998 and 1999) and I was the moderator of a special forum on nursing home staffing sponsored by the Committee (1999). I have continued to serve as an unpaid consultant to the Senate Special Committee on Aging, the Senate Finance Committee, and members of Congress. During the past two years, I worked informally with the National Quality Forum on nursing home quality and staffing issues on their new quality indicators. In 1999, I testified before the California legislature on staffing and nursing home quality. These efforts led to budget legislation on higher minimum staffing standards and salary increases for all California nursing home staff in 1999.

In conjunction with my interest in quality of care, I served as a member of the Institute of Medicine Committee to Study Nursing Home Regulation in 1986 and again on the Institute of Medicine's Committee on the Adequacy of Nursing Staffing in Hospitals and Nursing Homes in 1995-96. I was elected to the Institute of Medicine in 1996 and I served on the Institute's Roundtable on Quality of Care. In 1999-2001, I served as a member of IOM Committee on Quality in Long Term Care which published a report Assuring the Quality of Long Term Care (2001), in which I played a major role in developing the report. I also presented my staffing research at a US Congress briefing in 2002. In 2002-2003, I served on the IOM Committee on Work Environment for Nurses and Patient Safety and played a role in writing Keeping Patients Safe in 2003, which made recommendations on staffing levels and patient safety in hospitals and nursing homes. In 2007, I testified before the House US House of Representatives Ways and Means Committee, Subcommittee on Health on the quality problems of nursing homes owned by chains and private equity companies that led to changes in ownership, staff, and cost reporting in the Affordable Care Act of 2010.

Since 2008, I have conducted a number of research studies on nursing home staffing and quality in US nursing homes with a focus on large nursing home chains. These studies have shown the low staffing and poor quality in for-profit and chain nursing homes and the problems with regulatory oversight.

Consumer Information

As part of the AHCPR study (1995-1999), I designed a consumer information system for nursing homes for the country. In 1998, I served as a consultant to the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) (now Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services) to assist with implementation of my information system design on the CMS Medicare Nursing Home Compare Internet Website for all nursing homes in the US.

This work led to my funding as a P.I. by the California HealthCare Foundation (\$2 million, 1990-02) to establish a web-based model consumer information system for California nursing facilities, working with a consortium of three other academic centers (University of California, Los Angeles, University of Wisconsin, and RAND). The website (www.calnhs.org) was launched in the fall of 2002 and was funded to update the data on a quarterly basis and make improvements in the site. Numerous articles have been with colleagues on the website projects in several journals on consumer information systems. The website was expanded to include all licensed long term service and support (LTSS) providers in California including home health, hospice care, and ICF/DD. The website now called www.calqualitycare.org rates nursing homes and other LTSS providers and covers 20,000 LTSS providers. It has been continuously funded since 2002-2016. Direction and management of the website was assumed by Dr. Leslie Ross in 2012 while I have served as a Co-PI.

Since 2008, I have served on the Technical Expert Panel for Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Medicare 5-Star Nursing Home Compare Website. I served on the National Quality Forum long term care committee and many other government technical advisory committees.

International Health /Care

Finally, I have a strong research interest in international health policy and long term care. During my sabbatical in the U.K. in 1997, I studied the UK health system and completed a comparative analysis of long term care in the US and the UK with Dr. Allyson Pollock (*Lancet*, 1998). I completed two papers on the new long term care social insurance model in Germany with two colleagues (*Milbank Quarterly* 2000) and the *J. of Public Health Policy* (2002). I also published an article on the US nursing home industry in the *British Medical Journal* (2001). I am continuing my research on long term care policies and labor markets in Germany, the U.K., and the U.S. I have continued my studies on long term care in the U.K. and consulted with faculty at the University College of London and the University College in Bergen Center on Aging. Since 2010, I have worked on a collaborative study of nursing homes in 6 counties funded by the Canadian Research Council with Armstrong, Pat PI. Reimagining long-term residential care: an international study of promising practices. The collaborative has met annually and published numerous comparative research articles in international journals over the 2008-2018 period.
